

2022 MINUTES  
MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

The April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Annual Town Meeting of the Mcleansboro Township was called to order by Clerk Richard Woods. There were no public comments.

**Election of Moderator**

Jamie McNeil nominated Eva Lynn Gray to be the Moderator at this years meeting. The nomination was seconded by Bob Brockett. Nomination passed unanimously. As established at the last town meeting, the salary for the Moderator will be \$35.00.

The Moderators Oath of Office was administered by Clerk Woods.

**Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

As requested by the Moderator, minutes from the 2021 meeting were read by the Clerk. There being no corrections, a motion was made by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Becky Cross to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

**Establishment of Moderators Salary for 2023**

A motion was made by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Clydus Gray to set the Moderators salary for the 2023 Town Meeting at \$35.00. Motion carried.

## **New Business**

- **Items to Discard:** Clydus Gray indicated an unused typewriter that no longer works has been designated to be discarded. There was no objection to that declaration.
- **Annual Financial Report:** The completed annual financial report for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2022 was distributed and reviewed by those in attendance. After examination, a motion by Becky Cross and seconded by Bob Brockett to approve that report. Motion carried.

Township Clerk Woods was directed to make arrangements to place a copy of the financial report in the local newspaper as required by statute.

**Transfer of Funds:** After discussion, Clydus Gray made a motion to transfer a total of \$110,000.00 to both the Road and Bridge and Permanent Road Funds. Those transfers are as follows: \$65,000.00 from the Town Fund, \$25,000.00 from the Cemetery Fund and \$20,000.00 from the Social Security Fund. That motion was seconded by Kyle Ingram. Motion carried.

There being no further business to conduct, motion to adjourn was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Dennis Johnson. Motion carried.
