## MAY 2023 MINUTES MAY 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2023 ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP DECENNIAL COMMITTEE

The May 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2023 organizational meeting of the Township Decennial Committee was called to order by Supervisor Clydus Gray. This meeting is the first of a minimum of three meeting required by ILCS 70/1 Illinois statute signed into law by Governor Pritzker on June 10, 2022.

The first order of business was an overview of the requirement that each Township study and prepare a report both efficiencies and deficiencies to the County Board within 18 months of the initial meeting.

- **Establishment of the Committee**: It was decided that, due to the size of the Township, the committee will be a joint project by both the Townhip and the Road District.
- **Appointment of Committee Members:** The statute requires the committee consist of the Supervisor, all Trustees, two residents of the Township to participate on behalf of the Township and and one resident to represent the Road District. The two members to be part of the Township portion of the committee were Eva Lynn Gray and Richard Woods. Representing the Road District will be Jamie McNeil.
- <u>- Responsibilities:</u> Page nine of the March 2023 Perspective magazine lists numerous Supervisor Gray requested each member become familiar with each of those item. In addition, the Supervisor requested each member email him any thoughts regarding steps to be taken to correct deficiencies or, any comments commending the Township for their work. Those documents will be copied and placed with the current minutes.
- **Adjournment**: Pending the scheduling of the next committee meeting, a motion to adjourn was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Kyle Ingram. Motion carried.
