The discussion centered around the feasibility of having them repaired versus the purchase of new ones. It was mentioned that, at today's prices, it would be more cost effective to simply purchase new machines.

Miscellaneous:

- On behalf of the Board, Clydus expressed sympathy to Becky Cross's family on the loss of their son and brother. The Supervisor also noted a thank you card had been received from Bob Prince's family for the Cemetery Board's donation to the Fox Meadows Assisted Living Facility.
