

NOVEMBER 2020 MINUTES
MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

The November 10th, 2020 Township board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Clydus Gray. The meeting was held at the McLeansboro Township building.

There were no public comments.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Minutes from the October 2020 meeting were read by the Clerk. As there were no corrections to be made, a motion to approve the minutes, as written, was made by Jamie Ellis and seconded by Kyle Ingram. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Tax Levy Receipts: Supervisor Gray said the second installment of tax receipts based on the previous year's levy, has been received. That payment amounted to \$102,738.23. To-date, the Township has received total payments of \$398,151.98. While additional receipts will, more than likely take place, the bulk of what was expected for the year has been received.

Election Caucuses: Richard Woods gave a short report on preparations that are taking place in for the political caucuses which will take place on December 1st. It has been determined the Republican caucus will take place at 6:00 P.M. with the Democrat caucus occurring at 7 O'clock. In addition to the caucus, a lottery will also take place to determine party placement on the ballot.

New Business

Salaries: Statutes require that any salary changes for the upcoming term that begins on May 15th, 2021 must be set at the November Township meeting preceding that date. After discussion, a motion to give an 8 percent across-the-board increase was made by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Becky Cross. Motion carried with one Trustee voting "present".

Monthly Claims

Road and Bridge Fund, Building and Equipment Fund, Permanent Road Fund and Joint Bridge claims were provided for review. Motion by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Kyle Ingram to pay those bills. Motion carried.

Town Fund and Social Security Fund claims were also presented to the Board. Motion by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Dennis Johnson to pay those bills. Motion carried.

There being no further business to conduct, motion to adjourn was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Jamie Ellis. Motion Carried.
