

OCTOBER 2018 MINUTES  
MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

At the designated time, the October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Township board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Clydus Gray. The meeting was held at the local Township building.

There were no public comments.

**Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

Minutes from the September meeting were read by the Clerk. As there were no corrections to be made, a motion was made by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Kyle Ingram to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

**Correspondence**

- Supervisor Gray stated a letter to SCF Marine has been prepared requesting payment of approximately \$900.00 be submitted to the Township. This payment will bring the annual perpetual balance up to the required amount.

**New Business:**

- On August 19<sup>th</sup>, Governor Rauner signed Senate bill 2923 (now known as Public Act 100-0983) into law. Beginning January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, this law requires Township Clerks to “attest” the signature of the Supervisor on all payouts from the Township and Road District accounts. As agreed to by the Clerk, he will personally attest to each and every signature except, in his absence, he will verbally or in writing, approve the Deputy Clerk to perform this duty. At some point, the Clerk may choose to have a stamp of his signature made for this purpose. Motion by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Becky Cross to approve the Clerk’s decisions. Motion carried.

### **Monthly Claims**

- Road and Bridge Fund, Building and Equipment Fund and Permanent Road Fund claims were presented for review. Motion by Becky Cross and seconded by Jamie Ellis to pay those bills. Motion carried.
- Town Fund and Social Security Fund claims were also presented for review. Motion by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Kyle Ingram to pay those bills. Motion carried.

As there was no further business to conduct, motion to adjourn was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Kyle Ingram. Motion carried.
