

OCTOBER 2021 MINUTES  
MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

The October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Township board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Clydus Gray. The meeting was held at the local Township building.

There were no public comments.

Attending the meeting, as observers, were eight local High School Seniors.

**Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

Minutes from the September 2021 meeting were read by the Clerk. As there were no corrections to be made, a motion to approve the minutes, as written, was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Kyle Ingram. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

There was no old business to discuss.

**New Business:**

- **Letter Regarding the Coal Mine Road:** Supervisor Gray read a letter addressed to SCF Marine Inc., requesting two payments relating to the coal mine road. First, the letter noted (as per a long standing agreement) their annual payment of \$10,000.00 towards maintaining the Coal Mine Road bank account at \$100,000.00 is due within 30 days. In addition, the letter also requests payment of \$24,941.02 representing work completed on the road. A copy of the bill relating to that work was attached to the letter.

**Tax Levy Receipts:** – Supervisor Gray further noted the second payment of our portion of real estate taxes collected has now been received. That payment totaled \$89,773.44 making the total amount received year-to-date as being \$375,809.46. This total represents approximately 91% of the final extended tax levy.
