

**SEPTEMBER 2022 MINUTES
MCLEANSBORO TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING**

The September 13th, 2022 Township Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Clydus Gray. The meeting was held at the McLeansboro Township building at 105 Carpenter Street. There were no public comments.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Minutes from the August 2022 meeting were read by the Deputy Clerk. There were no corrections to be made. Therefore, a motion was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Bob Brockett to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- It was noted the Township building has been painted and the painters also located and fixed the areas that were causing leaks.
- The audit review was done by Katrina Roberson Accounting and, at the time of this meeting, the final copy of the audit had not been finished for presentation to the Township Board for approval. It was agreed by the Board that the audit report, when received, will be filed with the State of Illinois Comptroller's office before the end of September due date. After that, the Township Board will approve the final copy of the final audit copy at the October meeting.
- A discussion was held in regard to several complaints about the Township cemeteries not being mowed on a regular basis.

New Business:

- The first tax levy payment has been received with approximately \$120,000 still left to be received.
- It was also noted that the Township will owe \$5,000 to the Hamilton County Treasurer in September 2023 which will complete the purchase of the building and land agreed to by the County Board. Since the current County Clerk will be leaving office, a motion was made by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Kyle Ingram to go ahead and pay that payment in October 2022 to finalize the purchase. Motion carried.

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- Supervisor Gray said the Coal Mine Road letter has been written and mailed to SCF Marine regarding a \$10,000 payment now due towards the upkeep of the road.

- Papers were given to the Board members regarding a tax abatement Nathan Birkner has with the Unit 10 School District. The Township Board will look them over before the October meeting and Mr. Birkner has requested the matter be placed on the October agenda to discuss a similar situation with the McLeansboro Township.

Monthly Claims

- Road and Bridge Fund, Building and Equipment Fund and Permanent Road Fund claims were provided to the board for review. Motion to pay those bills was made by Becky Cross and seconded by Bob Brockett. Motion Carried.
- Town Fund and Social Security Fund claims were also presented to the Board. A motion to pay those bills was made by Kyle Ingram and seconded by Bob Brockett. Motion carried.

There being no further business to conduct, motion to adjourn was made by Dennis Johnson and seconded by Becky Cross. Motion Carried. .
